## NOTICE OF RACE

The Organising Authority is the Chichester Harbour Federation (CHF) in conjunction with Hayling Island Sailing Club (HISC) PO11 9SL. This notice may be amended until 1 August 2010

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Racing rules 27.2 (moving starting marks), 32 (shortening or abandoning after the start), 29.2 (recalled starts for series 3), 61.1(2) (informing the protestee), 63.1, A4 and A5 (penalties) will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.3 Competitors should note that the organising authority implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the charter, which can be found in the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012) or at <http://www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter>

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats as per the race programme.
- 2.2 Entries may be made on line at [www.chifed.org](http://www.chifed.org) until 2200hrs on Fri 6 Aug, or in person at the HISC clubhouse on Sat 7 Aug 13.00-17.00 hrs, Sun 8 Aug 13.00-18.00 hrs and 9-13 Aug from 08.00 hrs.
- 2.3 All helms (and if under 18, their parent or guardian) must complete the entry form accepting the conditions of entry.
- 2.4 A change of helm or boat constitutes a separate entry.
- 2.5 The race committee reserves the right to withdraw a competitor's entry at any time (without refund of entry fee) for any race or races, if a competitor or competitor's guest is found to have misbehaved either afloat or ashore in a manner unsuitable for a family regatta week, including the use of inappropriate language. This applies whilst attending any CHF club.
- 2.6 Competitors must grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any report, result, motion or still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the events.

### 3 FEES

- 3.1 Entry Fees (per boat):  
ADULTS: £38 for the series or £14 per day, (Single/Handed £33 or £12)  
YOUTH: (under18 on 9.8.2010) £26 for the series or £10 per day, (S/H £22 or £8).
- 3.2 Other fees: boats over 3m not already in possession of a Chichester or Langstone Harbour Plaque will be charged additionally £3.50 for the week or £2 for up to two days

### 4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Classes (events), class flags and start times will be as per the race programme
- 4.2 Handicaps will be RYA Portsmouth Yardstick (PY) numbers unless otherwise set by the race committee. Boats without a PY number may apply to enter events 1, 2, 4, 10 & 15.
- 4.3 There will be one race a day for Series 1 and 2. For Series 3, there will be two races Monday to Thursday, the second immediately following the first, and one on Friday.
- 4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Monday 9 Aug is 10:25.

### 5 MEASUREMENTS

Boats and equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with class rules.

### 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the CHF website <http://www.chifed.org> not later than 1 Aug. They will also be available at registration.

### 7 VENUE

- 7.1 The event is based at Hayling Island Sailing Club, Sandy Point, Hayling Island, PO11 9SL
- 7.2 Racing will take place in Chichester Harbour. A chart of the racing area will be available on the CHF website not later than 1 Aug.

### 8 THE COURSES

The courses will be issued with the Sailing Instructions at registration.

## **9 PENALTY SYSTEM AND PROTESTS**

- 9.1 The exoneration penalty at 30% and RYA Alternative Disputes Resolution (as modified by the CHF) will be implemented. Details will be available on the CHF website not later than 1 Aug and will also be posted on the Official Notice Board.

## **10 SCORING**

- 10.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2 (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.  
(b) When four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.  
(c) When five or six have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.  
(d) When seven or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.

## **11 PRIZES**

- 11.1 Prize giving will take place after racing on Friday 13 Aug.
- 11.2 Prizes will be awarded for each event according to the declared number of entries:  
Three entries – 1 prize, five entries – 2 prizes, seven entries – 3 prizes;  
each additional nine entries – 1 prize.
- 11.3 Trophies will be awarded to the winners of events as follows:

- 11.4 Any club may nominate to the race office before the first race on Tuesday a team of up to five boats, each helmed by a member of that club. No more than two of those boats may sail in the same event, (only one boat from events with less than six entries) Places of the best three boats will count, plus the next best in the event of a tie, points being scored according to their overall places.

## **12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **13 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat must be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 million per claim per event.
